

Digg Kids- Week 4

Objective: *Children will experience what it's like to follow God.*

Time: 15 to 20 minutes

Preparation: Set up a clue hunt in your home. Write clues that describe specific locations. Place the clues where kids will find each one and be led to the next clue. For example, start the hunt with a clue such as "Look in the place where we have dinner," and place the second clue at your table. Place at least four or five different clues. The last clue should lead kids back to your meeting place.

• How did you find your way back here?

Read aloud [Genesis 12:1-9](#).

ASK:

- How is what we did similar to what Abram did?
- What clues did Abram follow?
- How was Abram faithful to God?
- How can we be faithful in following God?

SAY: Abram followed God faithfully, even when he didn't know where God was leading him. We can 🖱️ **GO WHERE GOD DIRECTS US ONE STEP AT A TIME, JUST AS YOU DID IN THE CLUE HUNT.**

ASK:

- Where do we get the clues that teach us how to 🖱️ **GO WHERE GOD DIRECTS US?**
- How can you follow God this week?

You can also use this time to talk with your kids about a time in your life when you needed to follow God's directions on something. You can share about how it can be difficult to do.
